SCOLIOSIS PRESENTATION



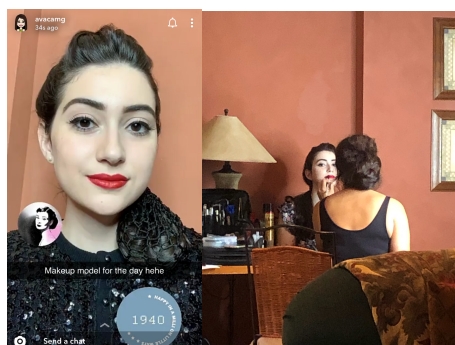
